#### **Bulletin Reflection Solemnity of Corpus Christi 2020**

This Sunday we celebrate the Solemnity of Corpus Christi, the Body and Blood of Christ, the source and summit of our faith. We are reminded of how Jesus is fully present in the consecrated bread and wine.

To reflect and to write about this Sacrament most Holy goes against the grain of my own Spirituality, as I believe that any words of mine will fail so miserably to express this gift given to us. Silence would be my most appropriate response.

However, here are just a few words: It is through the Holy Spirit that the Word was made flesh in the Incarnation. At the consecration it is through the Holy Spirit, as the priest speaks in the words of Jesus, that it is Jesus himself who speaks and transforms the elements of bread and wine to that of his own Eucharistic presence. And it is through the gift of the Holy Spirit that we dare to consume what we experience in faith.

Maybe then, we can use this time away from our Church buildings to ask the Holy Spirit to renew our Faith, to bring us to life, to cleanse and refresh us, so that we are enabled to see and understand how much we are loved by God, made visible through the sacrifice of Jesus in the Mass.

O Sacrament most holy! O Sacrament divine! All praise and all thanksgiving be every moment Thine.

## **Diocesan News**

#### Please be aware of the developing situation regarding the Coronavirus

Masses will be celebrated by Parish Priests but **without a congregation** on a daily basis. Congregations can join in spiritual communion with priests. **All Sacraments** will be deferred until such time that congregations can gather safely.

Bishop Robert Byrne announces the first five Churches to reopen for individual prayer: HM Government has announced that churches and other places of worship are set to open for individual prayer from 15 June 2020. But, as advised by Cardinal Vincent Nichols, President of the Catholic Bishops' Conference of England and Wales, not all churches will immediately reopen due to the ongoing Covid-19 safety measures to protect clergy, parishioners, staff and volunteers. There will be a phased opening of more churches after safety measures have been assessed and implemented. The first five churches to reopen for individual prayer in the Diocese of Hexham & Newcastle are: St. Mary's Cathedral, Newcastle, St. Aidan's, Ashington, St. Patrick's, Consett, St. Mary's, Sunderland, St. Joseph's, Hartlepool. Further details, including the date and times of opening, will be announced as they become available.
