In this Sunday's Gospel Jesus goes home with his disciples. He has been teaching all over Galilee and outside it but he has not yet taught in his hometown, Nazareth. It is the Sabbath and he teaches in the synagogue. The people are astonished at his teaching just as they were in Capernaum but they refused to accept him because they know him and his family and how he grew up among them and how he worked as a carpenter. They question the origin of his wisdom and his wonderful deeds, they cannot see beyond the person they know to discern the presence of God, they also cannot comprehend how someone they know so well might move them so powerfully. Sometimes we find it hard to see the grace of God near to us. In the ordinariness of life and of love, of misunderstanding and hurt, of care and compassion, the grace of God and the love of God are active and alive. What makes all the difference in the world is a deeper appreciation for everyone and everything that is around us.
